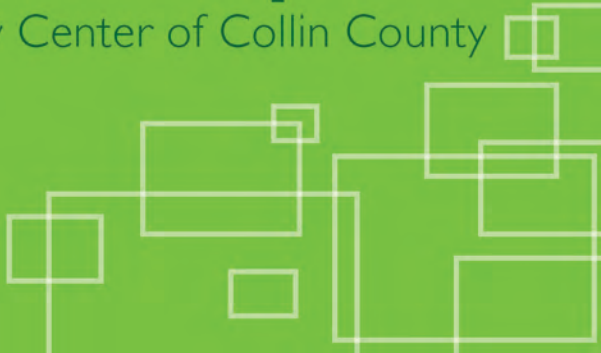

2015 was a record-breaking year at Children's Advocacy Center of Collin County. We experienced a 14% increase in clients served, and all the while we continued to maintain zero waiting lists for our core services. We also achieved a four star rating from Charity Navigator for the fifth consecutive year. We are extremely proud of the quality of services we provide to the children and families in Collin County who need us and the stewardship of every dollar you have given to make it possible.

It has been an incredibly positive year ... but the need for our services in Collin County only continues to grow. 2015 In Review

We conducted **1,081** forensic interviews for **1,032** clients, a **25%** increase over 2014.



2,276 clients received **7,336** Community Resource services, an increase of **11%** in clients served and a **5%** increase in services provided.



The Rainbow Room served **989** clients, about **2%** more than the previous year.



323 clients received **1,418** victim advocacy services through our Family Advocacy program, an increase of **93%** in clients served and **46%** in services provided.



114 children received child-sensitive pediatric sexual assault examinations or physical abuse and neglect examinations from our medical providers.



2,873 children received child care from trained volunteers, staff and interns in our Activity Center.



1,346 clients received **15,239** therapy services, a jump of **8%** in clients served and **3%** in services provided.



We conducted **249** Case Staffings, which enable the multi-disciplinary team to come together to evaluate cases and ensure children and families receive appropriate services.



35 children attended Kids In Court, which familiarizes children with the courtroom setting prior to taking the witness stand in a criminal trial.



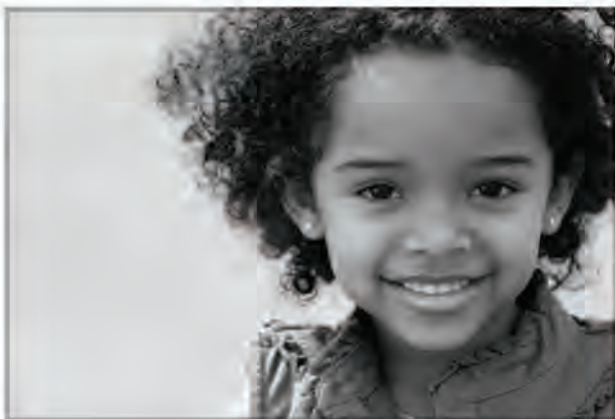
21,363 adults and children were educated about abuse through our Community Education initiative, including **11,821** through the Kids Count Players program.




Our special fundraising events raised approximately **\$700,000** to benefit the abused and neglected children we serve.



1,953 volunteers provided **10,294** unpaid hours of service. We experienced an astonishing **87%** jump in volunteers and **15%** increase in hours of service.



Our Accomplishments

- › The Crimes Against Children division of the Collin County District Attorney's office maintained a conviction rate of more than 90% thanks to collaboration across agencies.
 - › Janetta Michaels, Senior Vice-President of Operations, co-authored a chapter in the Child Maltreatment Encyclopedia on The Role of Law Enforcement in Child Abuse Cases with Plano Detective Jeff Rich.
 - › Dan Powers, Senior Vice-President and Clinical Director, was reappointed to the Texas Children's Justice Act Task Force by Gov. Greg Abbot and currently serves as the task force's vice-chair.
 - › We increased our social media involvement for special projects netting more efficient and effective donations to benefit the children served by our Holiday Project and Back-to-School Fair.
 - › CACCC staff members presented at a number of local, state and national conferences including the Crimes Against Children Conference and the Children's Advocacy Centers of Texas annual conference.
 - › Art Therapist Monica Salinas was named President of the North Texas Art Therapy Association.
 - › To address diverse client needs in northern Collin County, our clinical team started three new therapy groups for elementary-aged girls, parents and teens at our McKinney satellite office.
 - › We worked with our multidisciplinary team to ensure that every child who meets the criteria for a forensic interview receives one, resulting in a 25% increase in interviews provided.
 - › We continued to have no waiting lists for any of our core service areas: Forensic Interviews, Community Resources, Family Advocacy and Therapy.
 - › Our Family Assistance team put resources in place to benefit families caring for their relative children, strengthening kinship placements and helping keep children with family instead of in foster care.

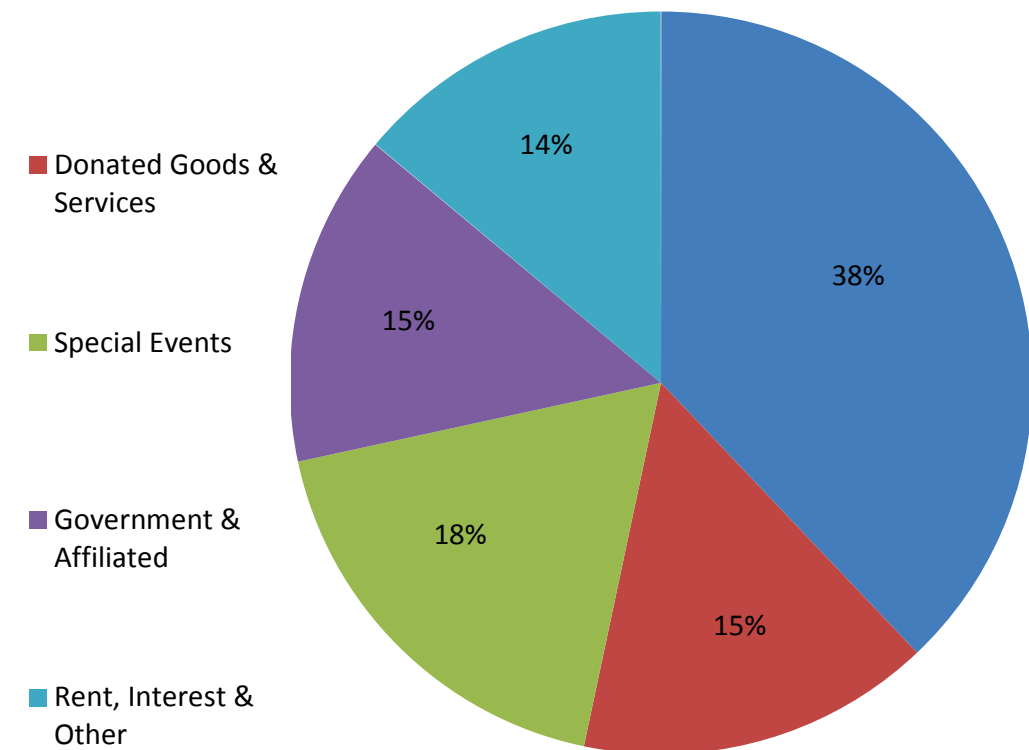

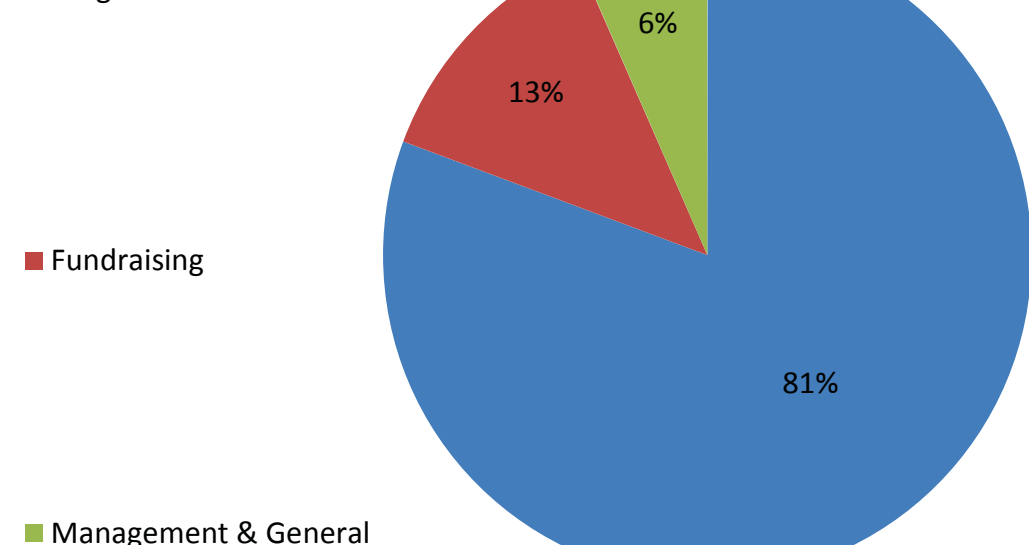

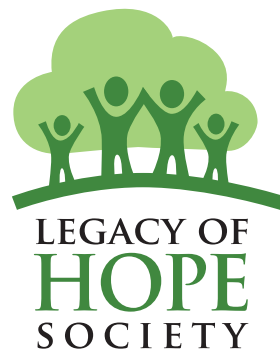
