Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse

This workshop teaches adults how to recognize the signs and symptoms of physical abuse, sexual abuse, emotional abuse, and neglect. Participants will learn facts about child abuse, how to recognize the physical and behavioral signs of the varying forms of abuse, as well as important details of how to report suspected abuse. We will discuss risk factors, effects of abuse, how to handle disclosures, and reporting laws.

Parenting the Digital Generation

Despite the constantly changing digital landscape, this workshop informs parents on how to protect children as they navigate the digital world. The program covers the four biggest risks for children online and the conversations you need to be having with them. Recommendations will be given on how you may utilize technology to better protect your children.

Darkness to Light's Stewards of Children

An innovative, evidence-based, child sexual abuse prevention curriculum, Stewards of Children focuses on adult training because ultimately it is our responsibility to keep children safe. The material is presented in a way that is empowering and encouraging.

Protective Parenting Program

This workshop seeks to empower parents and caregivers on keeping their children better protected from abuse. This training will discuss the conversations you should be having with your children, questions you should be considering to make their environments safer, and common tactics of offenders.

The Kids Count Players

The Kids Count Players is a volunteer puppet troop who perform for kindergarten through second grade students, educating them about personal safety, boundaries, private touches, and the difference between surprises and secrets. The program provides children with critical information to help them stay safe from abuse.
